Amiens Christmas Market is in the heart of the city. It is one of the biggest and best Christmas markets in northern France with 135 stalls. There is also an open air ice rink, merry-go-rounds, singers and shows. There is also the "Cathedral in Colour" - a free light show from 1st December to 1st January; "never is the striking Gothic cathedral more ethereal". Once you have visited the stalls, make time to fully discover this city of culture. With a number of World Heritage sites, such as the Cathedral, as well as associations with the writer Jules Verne this city has a lot to offer. And with over 700 shops, the pre-Christmas shopper will be spoilt for choice.

Cost will include:

#### 3 nights B&B in the Mercure Cathedrale Amiens - Amiens

This hotel is located in the heart of the city center. Right next to the Gothic cathedral, it is an ideal location for visiting the historic Saint Leu district, Jules Verne's house and the Les Hortillonnages gardens.
